FREERIDE RULES

- Never go touring or freeriding alone
- Check the avalanche report and weather every day
- Never go freeriding without LVS equipment
 LVS ◆ shovel ◆ probe
- Before you start and after every break check the battery ◆ LVS ◆ Handy
- In case of bad weather and flat light don't go freeriding • most of the time you can't find a useful line
- Avalanche danger 3 don't do slope's above 35°
 Avalanche danger 4 don't go freeriding
- Don't ski behind fresh snowcornise
- Ski steep slopes always one by one and watch for save places where you can wait together
- Ski safe, prudently, fast and without falling, don't make sprayturns and stops in steep terrain.



FREERIDE RULES

- Never bring others in danger!
 Watch first what or who is above or below you.
- Accept closed areas!
- Get the location information, in the most areas the locals will help you.

AVALANCHE RESCUE

- Keep cool and try to escape to the side
- Is it to late to escape, try to release the ski's and poles
- Activate ABS, Avalancheball or avalung.
- Try using backstroke to remain at the surface IMPORTANT: keep your head on the surface
- When the avalanche get slower close your mouth and keep the hands in front of your face and create a breathing space
- When the avalanche stopps try to stay cool to save oxygen and energy!
